**Relevance of strategy (according to the MOU)**

Innovation (in both its social and technological meaning) and sustainability are core fields of interest of both the involved institutions. By means of this agreement, UniMC and UnoChapecó agree to explore the possibility of joint investigation in these fields, in order to pursue their relevant strategic goals.


**Scientific and educational project and implementation:**

The possibility of joint cooperation in the abovementioned fields will take place within the framework of both already-existing and on-purpose investigation activities. In particular, UniMC Department of Law has an ongoing project on Innovation (also at PhD level), while a comprehensive teaching project on sustainability has been presented for funding under the Jean Monnet schemes in the field of sustainability. The cooperation between the two institutions could take place within both the mentioned projects, and even be strengthened by means of joint submissions for new calls in these and further fields.

**Expected aims and dissemination:**


The expected aims are precisely the possibility of joint submissions for international calls for research projects in the fields of interest of the parties. If successful, these efforts will lead to deliverables such as joint publications, and joint research events (conferences, seminars and webinars).

**IT IS AGREED AND WORDED AS FOLLOWS:**

**Project e implementation:**

Teaching staff from each involved institution, besides the scientific coordinators of the agreement will spend time in the partner institution in order to organize and take part into joint research and teaching activities.

During each period of mobility the teaching staff will offer at least 8 hours of academic lectures per week abroad. The subject and time of such teaching activity will be agreed with the partner university's coordinator for the agreement.

The periods of mobility will serve in order to plan and hopefully finalize the submissions for the calls the institutions intend to take part together.

Each institution agrees to provide the exchange teaching staff in mobility access to University's premises (libraries, classrooms, and so on), and a working space for the entire duration of the stay. UniMC will recognize the visitor the title of "Visiting fellow" if s/he will spend at UniMC at least 30 days, and upon the prior submission of a research project and the submission of a final report at the end of the mobility.




